NARCOTICS INTERDICTION UNIT OF THE YEAR (NIUY)**

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The Narcotics Interdiction Unit of the Year (NIUY) will be awarded annually to a narcotics interdiction group within the international law enforcement community that has distinguished itself through dedicated service, cooperation and achievement in drug interdiction duties. Because of the team or group concept in interdiction work, it is important to recognize those groups that have contributed to the end result of disrupting the flow of illegal drugs throughout the world. Nominated groups for consideration must be actively working domestic or international drug interdiction on a full or part-time basis. Groups must consist of three or more officers who conducted a particularly noteworthy investigation, series of investigations/seizures, or innovative interdiction techniques that resulted in significant seizures. The above activities should have been conducted and documented during the rating period of June 1, 2019 to the filing closure date April 15, 2020.

Submission of applications must be completed and returned (post-marked) to INIA no later than **April 15, 2020**. Nominations received after this date **will not** be considered for the NIUY award. Nominators can be any co-worker, supervisor, law enforcement officer or employee, or INIA member. All of the group members need not to be members of INIA. However, a representative of the group should be present at the INIA annual conference to accept the award.

Nominations should include the following information:

1. The background of the group;
2. A description of the group's accomplishments during the nomination period which should include such areas as specific cases involving interdiction of narcotics, innovative techniques in interdiction, and overall statistical performances involving the group, and cooperation with other interdiction groups, and;
3. Any additional qualifying information that will assist in selecting the group most worthy of the NIUY award.
